A View from the Vicarage

As dawn broke on the first Easter morning, Jesus' first disciples were hiding in their homes. His friends were frightened and fearful for the future. At best, they were worried about their livelihoods now that their Master had been taken from them. At worst, they were fearing for their lives. Would the authorities want to arrest and execute them, just as they had done to Jesus? Were their names next on the list?

But with the resurrection of Jesus their emotions were transformed. With the



discovery of the empty tomb and the appearances of their risen master, their fear turned to hope, their despair turned to joy. And just like those disciples on the first Easter morning, any fears we ourselves face can also be overcome. Because the resurrection of Jesus Christ remains as real and relevant today as it was 2000 years ago. Things like death, disease and redundancy do not have the last word for anyone who chooses to follow Christ. He says to us the same words he spoke to his startled disciples on the first Easter Sunday - "Do not be afraid!"

On that momentous morning God had breathed new life into Christ's corpse. In the most amazing miracle ever, a mortal body became immortal. And the Bible says that this transformation of Jesus' body is a wonderful foretaste of the resurrection that everyone who follows him can look forward to. A glorious prototype of the life they will one day enjoy in a wholly renewed creation.

The resurrection of Jesus was not a hoax or a hallucination, but the most precious moment in human history. So please do celebrate with us at St. John's this Easter!

Pause for Thought by Alan Dowen

'Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here; he has risen! Remember how he told you, while he was still with you in Galilee. Luke 24:5-6



Last month I wrote about failure but this month, I would like to address the balance and ask, "What does success look like?" I hope some of you

had a chance to watch Channel 4's 'The Piano', if you didn't it is still available on catch-up TV. In the second programme of the series, and again in the final concert, we met Lucy: a 13 year old girl who carries a duplicate copy of chromosome 16. Because of this she has severe learning difficulties, she finds it difficult to communicate and she has been blind from birth. If there were no more to her than that she would probably attract nothing other than sympathy and pity but ... listen to her play the piano (please ... listen to her play the piano) and you will be filled with admiration, awe and wonder, and probably even find a tear in your eye, because when she plays, she is truly amazing and her music is beautiful. Sometimes, incredible success appears from the most unlikely of places!

2,000 years ago a man from Nazareth had spent no more than three years teaching others about God's Kingdom and healing those in need: his whole demeanour had been that of a servant. But he was then taken, stripped, ridiculed and beaten before being executed in the most humiliating and painful manner leaving his followers bemused and afraid. Surely this is a comprehensive definition of failure and deserves no more than our sympathy and pity and yet, just three days later, that same man's tomb was found to be empty. Within hours, he reappeared to his disciples and 'opened their minds'. He had been transformed from a servant into a king and apparent failure had, yet again, been transformed into success. You see, it is always worth delving a little deeper before deciding what failure or success may look like.
