> Ash Wednesday 14th February Marks the start of Lent

View from the Vicarage

Snow fell here in Ashton Hayes and Mouldsworth last month, and there may yet be more to come before Winter's over. You may have heard that the Inuit language has over 50 words for 'snow'. Hardly surprising perhaps, when snow and ice are an ever-present reality for people living in an Arctic climate. In this country we only have one word in English for snow, and we're not particularly good at coping when it does fall. It only seems to take a few flakes of snow for our roads to be blocked, our trains to stop running and our economy to come grinding to a halt!



Snow is not something that features prominently in the Bible, which again is hardly surprising given the warm Middle Eastern climate in which it was written. Indeed, the word 'snow' only appears about twenty times in English translations of the Bible, compared to nearly two hundred references to the Sun! Yet one of the few biblical references to snow is particularly significant. It appears in Psalm 51, a psalm traditionally read on Ash Wednesday (which falls on 14th February this year). Psalm 51 is a prayer of confession to God, written by King David when he was seeking the Lord's forgiveness for his sins. And in verse 7 it says: "Cleanse me with hyssop, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow."

There is a purity and cleanliness about freshly fallen snow. And this perfect cleansing is exactly what God promises in this psalm to any repentant person, to every truly sorry sinner. Whatever our past (and King David's included murder and adultery!), we can be given a fresh start if we confess our wrongdoing to our Creator and seek his forgiveness for Christ's sake. Jesus Christ's perfect purity can be credited to us if we only ask. Wonderfully we can be as white as snow in our Lord's eyes. It's a truth to warm our hearts on these cold winter days!
