### What's on at St John's?

#### Our vision and needs

St. John's vision is to be a welcoming church that is 'Focused on Christ, united in faith and serving our community' of Ashton Hayes and Mouldsworth.

St John's holds an annual Gift Day to help us fulfil this vision and ensure that the church remains available as a resource for our local community. *This year's Gift Day is Sunday 8*<sup>th</sup> *June.* 

The total expenditure of St. John's was just over £56,000 last year - equivalent to over £1,000 a week. We currently average £570 a week in collections at services and planned giving, leaving a weekly shortfall of around £430 which we need to generate from fees, special events, donations and other fundraising activities.

Your generosity in response to our fundraising appeals over recent years has been greatly appreciated, and last year's Gift Day raised a total of £5,800.



## Where our money goes

At St John's the income we receive is used to fund our ministry activities, as well as the costs of our church building and administration. In 2024 these costs totaled £23,400.

We also pay a 'Parish Share' to Chester Diocese. This covers the cost of training, paying and housing clergy (including our own Vicar), as well as the diocesan support services we receive. It also enables our diocese to subsidise churches in disadvantaged areas. In 2025 our Parish Share is nearly £35,500.
