Pause for Thought

"For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, 'plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." Jeremiah 29:11

After twelve years of darkness, the Golden Lion has thrown its doors open once more, breathing life back into the centre of Ashton Hayes.

The beloved pub welcomed its first customers in early August to scenes of jubilation that felt almost biblical in their significance. It was like watching something rise from the dead! — a metaphor which surely resonates deeply in a community that has witnessed what can only be described as an act of resurrection.

The pub's restoration, thanks to the efforts of so many willing volunteers, mirrors the themes of redemption and renewal found throughout Christian theology. Just as parables speak of lost coins being found and prodigal sons being welcomed home, the Golden Lion represents something precious to us which has now been restored to its rightful place. The pub had been the village's central gathering place for decades, serving as both a sanctuary and a safe space for friends and neighbours to share their joys and sorrows — and now it has been restored.

The reopening draws parallels with themes of hope triumphing over despair and of community bonds proving stronger than economic hardship. And, as villagers filled every seat on its opening night, sharing stories and laughter, it became clear that this resurrection was a story of human determination and collective faith rather than divine intervention.


